**SERMON:** Spiritual Adultery

MAIN SCRIPTURE: Revelation 17:1-18 (NASB)

**SUPPORTING SCRIPTURE / FURTHER READING:** Genesis 11:1-9; 1 John 4:1; Philippians 1:9-10; 2 Timothy 3:12; Matthew 5:10; Colossians 1:17

**MESSAGE TAKEAWAY:** God will not force His love upon us. However, if we choose something or someone else to give our adoration, praise and worship, we will pay an eternal price.

## **SUPPORTING THOUGHTS:**

- Chapter 17 describes God's judgment of the religious system called "Babylon."
- Chapter 18 describes God's judgment of the political/commercial/economic system called "Babylon."
- The tower of Babel would symbolize humanity's greatness over God's greatness.
- Three foundations of man-made religion: 1) Rejection of God's promises (faithfulness); 2) Rebellion against God's commands (disobedience); and 3) Refusal of God's grace (legalism) (Chuck Swindoll)
- Babylon: The birthplace of false religion. The deathplace of false religion.
- "Harlot" is the false religious system.
- The harlot makes religion look pretty and she's riding on the back of political power and the object of worship, the Beast.
- Satan is under and controlling every false religion.
- Greatest movements of love and generosity have come from Christians.
- "At the very heart of our (Christian) view of reality is a man who died for his enemies, praying for their forgiveness." (Keller)
- Turbulence! Revelation 17:9-13 <u>Possible</u> Meanings of 7 Heads, 10 Horns
  - Seven Heads. Seven world empires that have stood in opposition to God.
    - Five from the past: Egypt, Assyria, Babylon, Medio-Persia, and Greece.
    - One is in the present (John's time) Rome.
    - One will arise in the future Babylon, empire of the Anti-Christ.
  - Seven Mountains. Rome was built on seven hills, so when you say a city was built on seven hills/mountains, you'd be referring to a miraculous city like Rome.
  - Seven Kings. Rulers over seven kingdoms. The Anti-Christ is one of the seven. His first kingdom is just as bad as the former kings. He's assassinated. He's resurrected. Now he's the eighth king.
  - <u>Eighth King</u>. After his "death" and "resurrection," the Anti-Christ will establish that eighth empire known as Babylon – the religious system and political-economic-commercial system that worships him and supports him.
  - Ten Horns. A global, ten-nation federation that rules the world for a short time ("one hour") and then the Anti-Christ, who is one of the rulers of those nations, will reign.
- End of one-world religion. This is the nature and outcome of evil. Evil eats itself.



## CHALLENGE: Practice Daily "Marriage" Maintenance

- **Spiritual Disciplines** help you grow in your faith and protect your marriage to Christ, **but you must have the right attitude**!
  - A longing to be transformed as you spend time with Jesus
  - o Prayer and solitude
  - o God's Word: Read, study, memorize scripture, put it to work in your life.
  - Fasting and worshiping
  - o Do something each day to grow in your faith.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- Who or what is the great prostitute? What is the significance of her riding on the Beast?
- How is this one-world religion like a prostitute?
- In this one-world religion, Christians will be targeted. What are some movements and ideologies afoot that could undermine Christianity?
- Read Micah 6:8. While social justice can be a good thing, how can it become its own religion/ideology and overtake the gospel, which is for everyone? (In other words, how can a possible good thing become something dangerous and antithetical to the gospel?)
- Read 2 Timothy 3:12 and Matthew 5:10. How do you think Christians will be persecuted? How have we been persecuted historically?
- We see in today's teaching that evil kills itself in the end, Satan destroys this one-world religion so that everyone will worship him (through the anti-Christ). What does this say about God's sovereignty? (Hint: Read Colossians 1:17)
- What religions of this world do you see competing with Jesus? What idols do you have to fight off in your own life so that Jesus has no competition?
- Describe in your own words "spiritual adultery." Give examples of how it can start small and then overtake your life. How can it happen collectively in a country, region, the world?
- Discuss Kip's challenge with your group. Where do you struggle? Where have you had success? Why is your attitude important in this?
