Challenge: Let your life be characterized by love, service, and respect for others.

Summary of verses 5-10

Verse 5: God is light; in Him there is not darkness at all.

Verse 6: If we claim to have fellowship with Him yet walk in darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth.

Verse 7: But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another.

Verse 8: If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.

Verse 9: If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Verse 10: If we claim we have not sinned, we make Him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.
