MAIN SCRIPTURE: Revelation 3:14-22 (NASB) SUPPORTING SCRIPTURE: Colossians 1:15-17; 1 Peter 1:6-7; Proverbs 3:12; Hebrews 12:11; Revelation 1:19

**MESSAGE TAKEAWAY:** Don't "buy the wrong rabbit." Only Christ is sufficient to meet our deepest physical, emotional, and spiritual needs.

# SUPPORTING THOUGHTS:



- "Amen, Faithful and True Witness, Creator" = Jesus is the source of all wealth and power, the ruler who truthfully reigns in every corner of the universe.
- Lukewarm: "Your church matches your water supply. Your deeds show your spiritual bankruptcy. You provide no healing and nothing refreshing."
- Laodicea: worldly wealth but no spiritual wealth.
- Trials in our lives burn off the dross in our character.
- Nakedness is a symbol of disgrace, shame and impending judgment.
- Jesus to the Laodiceans: "See yourself for who you really are spiritually blind. Repent and receive from Me true vision."
- Divine love leads discipline, which is a purifying process.
- Zeal = eagerness to get right with God. Zealous faith will replace a lukewarm life. Repent means to turn to Jesus with an "about face" in your life...and heart.
- "I stand at the door and knock": 1) A call to a weak church to repent; 2) a call to each person in the church to open their hearts to Christ.
- Important takeaway from Laodicea: Don't "buy the wrong rabbit."

**CHALLENGE:** Character assessment: Where have I "bought the wrong rabbit" in life? If you have "bought the wrong rabbit," be zealous and repent.

## "Buying the wrong rabbit" as a church:

- Unhealthy focus on metrics
- Fear of offending
- Playing in politics

## "Buying the wrong rabbit" as individuals:

- Unhealthy focus on success
- The need to be right rather than act, live righteously
- Desiring positions of influence rather than serving humbly for the Audience of One
- Thinking you're spiritually rich yet in reality you're spiritually bankrupt
- Works as a replacement for worship

- Kip mentioned that trials in our lives develop our faith and character if we respond well. Describe a time in which God burned the "dross" off your character through suffering.
- Related to that, we can go through difficult times because of sinful choices. When have you experienced the discipline of God? How did you respond? What were the results?
- Where in life have you "bought the wrong rabbit"? Did you change course/repent? If so, how and what were the results?
